



**COWICHAN MILLION LITRE CHALLENGE
MARCH 16-24**

To mark **UN World Water Day** (March 22) here in the Cowichan valley, our goal is to find 100 people who will test their hoses for leaks and fix them this week, resulting in 1 million litres of water saved over the course of the year.

By simply replacing your hose washers and tightening your hose connections you can save up to 240 litres a day!

Here's the math of a leaky hose:

10	litres per hour
24	hours/day
120	days/watering season
28,800	litres saved by fixing one leaky hose
100	participants
<u>2</u>	hoses per household on average
5,760,000	potential litres saved by fixing 200 leaky hoses
